

## ***Water from Jesus' Heart***

**John 7:37-39** <sup>37</sup> On the last day, the climax of the festival, Jesus stood and shouted to the crowds, "Anyone who is thirsty may come to me! <sup>38</sup> Anyone who believes in me may come and drink! For the Scriptures declare, 'Rivers of living water will flow from his heart.'" <sup>39</sup> (When he said "living water," he was speaking of the Spirit, who would be given to everyone believing in him. But the Spirit had not yet been given, because Jesus had not yet entered into his glory.) (NLT)

**John 7:6-10** <sup>6</sup> Jesus replied, "Now is not the right time for me to go, but you can go anytime. <sup>7</sup> The world can't hate you, but it does hate me because I accuse it of doing evil. <sup>8</sup> You go on. I'm not going to this festival, because my time has not yet come." <sup>9</sup> After saying these things, Jesus remained in Galilee. <sup>10</sup> But after his brothers left for the festival, Jesus also went, though secretly, staying out of public view. (NLT)

**Psalms 42:1** As the deer pants (longs, longeth) for streams of water, so my soul pants for you, my God. (NIV)

**Psalms 63:1** *A psalm of David.* O God, you are my God; I earnestly search for you. My soul thirsts for you; my whole body longs for you in this parched and weary land where there is no water. (NLT)

**Jeremiah 17:8** Such a person is like a tree by the waterside that thrusts its roots to the stream: when the heat comes it has nothing to fear, its foliage stays green; untroubled in a year of drought, it never stops bearing fruit. (NJB)

**Ezekiel 31:4-5** <sup>4</sup> Deep springs watered it and helped it to grow tall and luxuriant. The water flowed around it like a river, streaming to all the trees nearby. <sup>5</sup> This great tree towered high, higher than all the other trees around it. It

prospered and grew long thick branches because of all the water at its roots. (NLT)

**Exodus 17:6b** So Moses struck the rock as he was told, and water gushed out as the elders looked on. (NLT)

**John 7:37-38** <sup>37</sup> Jesus stood and shouted to the crowds, "Anyone who is thirsty may come to me! <sup>38</sup> Anyone who believes in me may come and drink! For the Scriptures declare, 'Rivers of living water will flow from his heart.'" <sup>39</sup>

**John 4:13-14** <sup>13</sup> Jesus replied, "Anyone who drinks this water will soon become thirsty again. <sup>14</sup> But those who drink the water I give will never be thirsty again. It becomes a fresh, bubbling spring within them, giving them eternal life." (NLT)

**John 7:39** <sup>39</sup> (When he said "living water," he was speaking of the Spirit, who would be given to everyone believing in him. But the Spirit had not yet been given, because Jesus had not yet entered into his glory.)

**1 Corinthians 12:3** <sup>3</sup> So I want you to know that no one speaking by the Spirit of God will curse Jesus, and no one can say Jesus is Lord, except by the Holy Spirit. (NLT)
