Acquiring a New Church-Wide Mindset

What does it take to be a great church? Well, the answer is the same as being a good Christian? Or, a good servant? Being a person of prominence often implies an expectation that others serve us, however, being a follower of Jesus Christ means we are *called* to serve others. That's a BIG difference!

Jesus modeled this BIG difference during his ministry on earth. He modeled humility! In Biblical times, the lowest servant in the house washed visitors' feet. Imagine God in human flesh washing the dirtiest feet, the feet of fishermen and those who worked with animals, and then saying to the recipient, "Follow my example; go and serve others now!" Download that picture into your mind every single day!!



What mindset is needed?

Philippians 2:5-9 ⁵ You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had. ⁶ Though he was God, he did not think of equality with God as something to cling to. ⁷ Instead, he gave up his divine privileges...took the humble position of a slave...humbled himself in obedience to God and died a criminal's death on a cross. ⁹ Therefore, God elevated him to the place of highest honor and gave him the name above all other names (the name of highest honor)."

How was Jesus able to humble himself and ministry to the least of the least among him? Three big issues he settled within himself that you and I also need to settle. First, he knew who sent and called him; second, Jesus knew who constantly and completely sustained him; and third, Jesus knew who was going to reward him. You see, when you know those three things in your life – then you are free!! Free from the fear of other people and their opinion of you; free from the fear of failure (judged by this world's standards, not by God's standards); free from the fear of rejection, which is dismissing your worth as a person and contribution to the world as a Christian. Pastor Rick Warren once said, "True humility is not thinking less of yourself; it is thinking of yourself less." However, the times you do think of

yourself you realize: 1) God called you, 2) God sustains you and, 3) God will reward you. You are no longer a servant to the recognition of others, you are a servant of others!!

We are in the summer months now and HVAC is always an issue, and since our building is closed most of the time, we must conserve energy and watch our utilities.

There have been occasions of late the lights have been left on. Please help us and turn off the lights when you are done using them.

We ask everyone to please avoid changing or adjusting the readings on the thermostats and observe the settings on all thermostats of 74 in the summer and 67 in the winter. We understand there may be times that you have to adjust the thermostats or turn on lights when you're in the building and using them, but If you must change the settings or turn on lights please return them to the original settings, and turn off the lights. The bills for HVAC and electric can be exceedingly high and this would be helpful. — Thank You.
