Romans 14:10b-12 Remember, we will all stand before the judgment seat of God. ¹¹ For the Scriptures say, “As surely as I live,” says the LORD, “every knee will bend to me, and every tongue will confess and give praise to God.” ¹² Yes, each of us will give a personal account to God. (NLT)
