The Efficacy of Jesus' Blood – Part Two

1 John 1:4-10 ⁴ We are writing these things so that you may fully share our joy. ⁵ This is the message we heard from Jesus and now declare to you: God is light, and there is no darkness in him at all. ⁶ So we are lying if we say we have fellowship with God but go on living in spiritual darkness; we are not practicing the truth. ⁷ But if we are living in the light, as God is in the light, then we have fellowship with each other, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, cleanses us from all sin. ⁸ If we claim we have no sin, we are only fooling ourselves and not living in the truth. ⁹ But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness. ¹⁰ If we claim we have not sinned, we are calling God a liar and showing that his word has no place in our hearts. 1) _____ in the **Blood of Jesus**

1 John 4:7 ...the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

1 John 1:9 But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness.

2) _____ in the **Blood of Jesus**

Ephesians 2:13 But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near through the blood of Christ.

Ephesians 2:14 For Christ himself has brought peace to us. He united Jews and Gentiles into one people when, in his own body on the cross, he broke down the wall of hostility that separated us.

Ephesians 2:19 So now you Gentiles are no longer strangers and foreigners. You are citizens along with all of God's holy people. You are members of God's family.

3) _____ in the **Blood of Jesus**

Colossians 1:20 And, having made peace through the blood of His cross, by Him to reconcile all things unto Himself ...

Ephesians 2:14 For he himself is our peace, who has made the two groups one and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility. (NIV)

Matthew 5:9 Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God.

4) _____ in the **Blood of Jesus.**

Revelation 12:11 And they have defeated him (Satan, the serpent) by the blood of the Lamb and by their testimony. And they did not love their lives so much that they were afraid to die.
